Are you a recent graduate who is looking for an opportunity to start an accounting and auditing career? Would you be confident in taking up this challenge and work with our State-Owned-Enterprises (SOEs) or Provincial Governments? A new and exciting opportunity has opened up for new graduates who have a suitable qualification in the area of Accounting and Finance and want to gain experience in auditing.

The internship will give you vital insight into the workings of the public sector and the role of the Auditor. We can offer successful applicants the chance to equip yourself with the relevant experience and skills to seek further employment opportunities in public or private sector.

As an intern, you will support one of two teams as they undertake financial statements audits. This work will include auditing to both IFRS and IPSAS Cash standards. We will nominate an experienced auditor from within our team to work with you and help you to apply our audit approach. You will be responsible for performing audit fieldwork as prescribed by our audit methodology.

This internship program will:

- ensure that you put into practice the accounting and auditing standards you learnt in your degree;
